In addition to the assignments that are recorded on Google Classroom, students are responsible to record homework assignments, reminders, and teacher directives in this Daily Journal copybook.

#### **Directions for Maintaining the Daily Journal**

DAILY Write the <u>Day</u> and <u>Date</u>.

- 1. Next to the left-hand margin, list the subject title for your first class period. Next to it write your assignment or, if there is no homework, write "None."
- Follow this pattern for each of the six subject periods (Religion, Math, Social Studies, Science, ELA-1, ELA-2 but do not pre-list the subject titles because sometimes you might need more than one line on which to write.
- After the six subject titles write REMINDERS.
   *\*\* WITH A RULER or a straight-ledge underline the date and the subject titles.*

Skip two copybook spaces and begin the next day's entries.
