
Wheat and Grapes: A Family Exercise

An exercise to prepare to participate in the Mass with attention, reverence and devotion


DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Consider the sufferings, sacrifices, hurts, disappointments, joys and accomplishments of the <u>past week</u> as the **grapes** that will become **wine** and eventually through the words of Consecration the **Blood of Christ**. Label each grape with something that you desire to offer to Jesus; to unite with Jesus's sacrifice of himself.
- 2. The kernels of **wheat** will become **bread** and eventually through the words of Consecration the **Body of Christ**. On the kernels of wheat label the ways that you need Jesus to feed you in the week ahead or ways that you desire to feed others in Jesus' name.
